Course Description: This is a course for patrol officers and investigators, that identifies concerns which are uncommon in more frequently investigated crimes, but do occur in some of the worst crimes and difficult scenes. Patrol officers and investigators will be involved, but most officers lack experience with homicide scenes and they may be truly rare for rural officers. Child abuse is a specialized area of investigation, but patrol officers are exposed to indicators that they may not recognize, and they are often the first responders to situations that expose child abuse and require special protective actions. Evidence in child abuse cases is often subtle and corroborative in nature, rather than obvious and direct, yet it is still crucial to the case. The class will also focus on WMD incidents as they increase around the world. Police at all levels need a basic understanding of the nature of the offenders, special dangers, and what role each involved agency will play in the response and investigation. Methamphetamine labs have become common, but the dangers they pose are uncommon to police outside of meth labs. Law enforcement continues to be poorly prepared for the very dangerous environment that is presented in meth labs. Finally, sexual assailants come in a variety of offender typologies. It is important for officers to recognize unusual evidence, and to understand what the evidence is telling them about the offenders, which is not so obvious. This often leads to additional victims and evidence.

This course will provide information on evidentiary indicators, special concerns in search warrants, dangers caused by evidence, and how to remedy problems. It will enable investigating officers to better recognize and preserve evidence, enhance their own safety, and present stronger prosecutions in crucial cases.

POST CREDIT: This course is co-sponsored by the Institute for Public Safety/Central Missouri Police Academy with the Missouri Safety Center and UCM. This is a P.O.S.T. certified training course providing. This 8-hour course offers 6 hours of Technical Studies and 2 hours of Legal Studies in the area of Tactical Training.

FEES: Tuition is \$90 and full payment is required before start of class.
