DRIVER EDUCATION I:
INTRODUCTION TO SAFETY EDUCATION**

CREDIT HOURS: 3

PREREQUISITE: None

An introductory course in the principles and fundamentals of safety education. It shows the concern for safety as a social problem and considers major accident areas, accident causes, liability, and analyzes possible solutions to the accident problem. A course aimed at developing concepts to prepare the driver education student to assume responsibility for accident prevention in the home, school, community, and on the highway.

An introduction to the task of the driver within the highway transportation system (HTS) with emphasis on high risk perception and management and the decision making process.

DRIVER EDUCATION IV:
DEVELOPING OPERATIONAL SKILLS**

CREDIT HOURS: 3

PREREQUISITE: DRED 2010 & 2020
